To mention the reference(source)such as :author's name ,and/ or title of the work ,date, etc),from which the pieces of information were collected and included in the researcher's study.
The information can be in different forms :words , ideas ,. etc..



✤ How to quote:

For example: -X says, explains, concluded, has observed that:"......" (source)

How to paraphrase(same length and all ideas) and <u>summarize(shorter and main ideas)</u>: For example:

-By reporting what X says or said: X says, said that(source) -By transforming into the passive: A ccording to X ,... (source)
