# **LESSON TWO: Usul al-Figh (The Principles of Islamic**

### Jurisprudence)

### I. Definition of Usul al-Figh

- 1. *The lexical meaning of Asl:* (plural usul)
  - Something from which another thing originates « Root ».
  - Somthing upon which another thing is constructed « foundation ».
  - In some cases asl is used in the sense of the word "مصدر" which means « Source ».
  - The basis in which something else is built (the origin of the tree).

#### 2. The technical meaning of Asl:

- The word asl is used to mean guide 'دليل'; a guide leading a caravan. The use of the term guide conforms with the term source.
- As is used in the sense of the original rule.
- The word asl is used to indicate the foundation uponn which analogy maybe used.
   E,g; wine (النبيذ) is an asl or basis for the prohibition of the (النبيذ) beverage

#### 3. <u>The Meaning of Usul Al-Fiqh</u>:

- Knowledge or science of those rules, which directly or indirectly lead to the science of fiqh.
- They are the principles by the use of which the mujtahid arrives at the legal rules through specific evidence.
- Principles that are used to study Shari'ah.
- The principles of Islamic Jurisprudence.

### II. Definition of Fiqh

#### 1. The lexical meaning of fiqh:

- It is an Arabic term, means "deep understanding" or "full copmrehension".
- 2. The technical meaning of fiqh:
  - Technically it refers to the body of Islamic law extracted from detailed Islamic sources, which are studied in <u>the principles of jurisprudence</u>.
  - Figh is defined as the knowledge of the practical rules of Shari'ah that have been acquired from the detailed evidence.

# > Fiqh occurs in six different variation twenty times in as many verses:

variation	meaning	count	verses
يفقهون	They understand	13	"they have hearts but they do not understand with them" (7.179)
			"this is because they are a people who do not understand" (59.13)
يفقهوه	They understand it	3	"we have laid veils on their hearts lest they understand it" (18.57)
يفقهوا	They understand	1	<pre>''so that they understand my words'' (20.28)</pre>
نفقه	We understand	1	"We do not understand much of what you say" (11.91)
تفقهون	You understand	1	''But you do not understand their glorification'' (17.44)
اليتفقهوا	To study	1	"to study religion" (9.122)

## III. The difference between Shari'ah, Figh and Usul al-Figh
