Types of (crime, infraction, misdemeanor, felony)

Pickpocketing : taking valuable things from another person's pockets.

Shoplifting: taking products from a shop without paying.

Traffic offenses: breaking the traffic rules.

Speeding : driving a vehicle beyond the legal speed limit.

Jaywalking: crossing the road at an undesignated spot.

Drunk driving: driving a vehicle after consumption of alcohol.

Running red light: going through traffic lights when they are red.

Vandalism: damaging a house or property intentionally.

Simple hurt: causing minor injuries to a person.

Bribery: giving money or granting favors to do something against the law.

Embezzlement: stealing a large amount of money that you are in charge of.

Forgery: to fake documents, currency to cheat others.

Hit and run: hit a person accidentally and run from that place.

Identity theft: using someone's personal information for one's own benefit.

Mugging: attacking someone to snatch valuable things.

Poaching: hunting illegally.

Looting: stealing something during a war, a riot, a fire etc.

Theft: stealing something

Hooliganism: being violent or aggression

Robbery: stealing a large amount of money with force

Murder: killing a person intentionally

Abduction kidnapping: taking someone against their will and hiding

Arson: setting fire to a property

Burglary: illegal entry to a building with an intent to commit a crime.

Human trafficking: illegally transporting people usually for slave or commercial sexual exploitation.

Rape: a sexual assault against a woman without her consent.

Hijacking: illegally getting control of an aircraft or vehicle.

Hacking: an unauthorized access to data in a computer system.

Smuggling: illegal import or export.

Drug trafficking: importing illegal drugs.

Assault: a physical attack.

Fraud: deception for personal or financial gain.

Patricide: killing one's own father

Child abuse: hurting a child physically, sexually, emotionally and psychologically.
