One of the greatest pens is the fountain pen, which is a pen for writing that uses liquid ink, which is the development of a feather or a reed that was used for writing. The pen contains a water-based liquid ink dispenser and is mixed with certain chemicals that help to slip the pen and give gloss to the written characters.

The first invention recorded for a pen containing a reservoir was in the tenth century. In 953, the caliph Al-Muizz li-Dîn Allah, asked for a pen that did not pollute his hands and clothes while writing. Al-Muizz li-Din Allah, born in 932 in Kutama (Algeria) and died in 975 in Cairo (Egypt), he is the fourth Fatimid caliph.
