

- 1. **Initiation:** This is the stage where the project is proposed and its objectives and scope are defined.
- 2. **Planning**: In this stage, a detailed plan for the project is developed, including a schedule, budget, and resource requirements.
- 3. **Execution**: This is the stage where the project is carried out and the work is completed.
- 4. *Monitoring and Control*: During this stage, progress is monitored and any necessary adjustments are made to keep the project on track.
- 5. <u>Closure</u>: This is the final stage in which the project is completed and evaluated, and any final deliverables are handed over to the customer.
