What is a Political System?

A **political system** is the way a country or state is organized to make, enforce, and judge laws.

It is how leaders are chosen, how rules are made, and how the country is managed.

Simply, it is the structure of how power is used and shared in a state.

¼ Why is a Political System Important?

Because it:

- Maintains order and security
- Protects people's rights and freedoms
- Decides how leaders are chosen
- Organizes how decisions are made for the people

Without a good system, a country would be in chaos.

□□ Main Functions of a Political System

- ✓ Make laws
- ✓ Enforce laws
- Settle disputes (through courts)
- ✓ Protect the country
- ✓ Provide public services (like schools, hospitals)

Types of Political Systems

There are different political systems in the world:

How it Works	Example
People vote to choose leaders and laws	USA, India
King/Queen rules — sometimes with a parliament	UK, Saudi Arabia
One person or small group has all the power	North Korea
People elect leaders, no king or queen	Algeria, France
Religious leaders rule based on religious law	Vatican City,
	People vote to choose leaders and laws King/Queen rules — sometimes with a parliament One person or small group has all the power People elect leaders, no king or queen

* Main Parts of a Political System

A political system has 3 main parts (called **organs of government**):

1. Legislative

- Makes the laws
- Example: Parliament, Congress

2. Executive □□

- Applies and enforces laws
- o Example: President, Prime Minister, Ministers

3. Judiciary ₺₺□

- Judges the laws and settles disputes
- o Example: Courts, Supreme Court

- Make good decisions as citizens
- Respect and follow laws
