Simple Present & Simple Past Tenses

- First, make an active voice question and statement (answer) using the words. Put the verb in the tense listed. Check your question by clicking the mouse.
- Next, make a passive voice question and answer using the same words (change the word order & verb form; omit the old subject/agent if it's not needed). Check your answer by clicking the mouse.



• Active Question:

How do people create ketchup?

Active Answer:

People *create* ketchup from tomatoes.

• Passive Question:

How <u>is</u> ketchup <u>created</u> (by people)?

Passive Answer:

Ketchup <u>*is created*</u> (by people) from tomatoes.





how / chefs / mayonnaise / make answer – from oil and eggs

simple present tense

• Active Question:

How **do** chefs **make** mayonnaise?

Active Answer:



Chefs make mayonnaise from oil and eggs.

• Passive Question:

How <u>is</u> mayonnaise <u>made</u> (by chefs)?

• Passive Answer:

Mayonnaise <u>is made</u> (by chefs) from oil and eggs.



where / farmers / grapes / grow answer - in California

simple present tense

Active Question:

Where **do** farmers **grow** grapes?

Active Answer:



Farmers grow grapes in California.

Passive Question:

Where *are* grapes *grown* (by farmers)?

Passive Answer:

Grapes *are grown* (by farmers) in California.

where / people / opals / find answer - in Tequila, Mexico simple present tense

• Active Question:

Where **<u>do</u>** people <u>**find</u>** opals?</u>

Active Answer:

People *find* opals in Tequila, Mexico.

• Passive Question:

Where <u>are</u> opals <u>found</u> (by people)?

• Passive Answer:

Opals *are found* (by people) in Tequila, Mexico.





where / farmers / potatoes / plant answer - in Poland

simple present tense

• Active Question:



Where **do** farmers *plant* potatoes?

Active Answer:

Farmers *plant* potatoes in Poland.

• Passive Question:

Where <u>are</u> potatoes <u>planted</u> (by farmers)?

• Passive Answer:

Potatoes are planted (by farmers) in Poland.



where / people / pho / eat answer - in Vietnam

simple present tense

• Active Question:

Where **do** people **<u>eat</u> pho?**

Active Answer:

People *eat* pho in Vietnam.

• Passive Question:

Where is pho <u>eaten</u> (by people)?

• Passive Answer:

Pho *is eaten* (by people) in Vietnam.





simple present tense

Active Question:

Why do farmers raise cows?

Active Answer:



Farmers *raise* cows for food and clothing.

• Passive Question:

Why *are* cows *raised* (by farmers)?

• Passive Answer:

Cows <u>are raised</u> (by farmers) for food and clothing.



why / people / aspirin / take answer – for headaches

simple present tense

• Active Question:

Why do people take aspirin?

Active Answer:

People *take* aspirin for headaches.

• Passive Question:

Why **is** aspirin **<u>taken</u>** (by people)?

• Passive Answer:

Aspirin is taken (by people) for headaches.



when / Americans / heart-shaped candy / give answer – on Valentine's Day simple present tense

Active Question:

When do Americans give heart-shaped candy?

Active Answer:

Americans give heart-shaped candy on Valentine's Day.

Passive Question:

When is heart-shaped candy given (by Americans)?

Passive Answer:

Heart-shaped candy is given (by Americans) on Valentine's Day.

Now, practice with the past tense!

• Remember:

- The auxiliary verb for the active voice changes from <u>do/does</u> to <u>did</u>.
- The auxiliary verb for the passive voice changes from <u>is/are</u> to <u>was/were</u>.

When / they / world's largest diamond / discover answer - in 1905 <u>simple past tense</u>

- Active Question:
- When <u>did</u> they <u>discover</u> the world's largest diamond?
- Active Answer:
- They <u>discovered</u> the world's largest diamond in 1905.
- Passive Question:

When <u>was</u> the world's largest diamond <u>discovered</u>?

Passive Answer

The world's largest diamond <u>was discovered</u> in 1905.

Where / someone / world's largest diamond / find answer - in South Africa <u>simple past tense</u>

Active Question:



- Where <u>did</u> someone <u>find</u> the world's largest diamond?
- Active Answer:
- Someone <u>found</u> the world's largest diamond in South Africa.
- Passive Question:
- Where <u>was</u> the world's largest diamond <u>found</u> (by someone) ?
- Passive Answer

The world's largest diamond <u>was found</u> (by someone) in South Africa.

Why /a company / cotton /grow /in Goodyear answer - to make tires simple past tense

Active Question:



Why *did* a company *grow* cotton in Goodyear?

Active Answer:

A company **grew** cotton in Goodyear to make tires.

Passive Question:

Why was cotton grown (by a company) in Goodyear?

Passive Answer

Cotton was grown (by a company) in Goodyear to make tires.

When/a tire company/cotton/grow/in Goodyear answer - in the 1940s simple past tense

Active Question:

When *did* a tire company *grow* cotton in Goodyear?

- Active Answer:
- A tire company grew cotton in Goodyear in the 1940s.
- Passive Question:

When was cotton grown (by a tire company) in Goodyear?

Passive Answer

Cotton was grown (by a tire company) in Goodyear in the 1940s.



When / someone / create / CDs answer – in 1982 <u>simple past tense</u>



Active Question:

When *did* someone *create* CDs?

• Active Answer:

Someone <u>created</u> CDs in 1982.

- Passive Question:
- When were CDs created (by someone) ?
- Passive Answer

CDs <u>were created</u> (by someone) in 1982?



How / Percy Spencer / discover / microwave cooking answer – accidentally simple past tense

- Active Question:
- How <u>did</u> Percy Spencer <u>discover</u> microwave cooking?
- Active Answer:
- Percy Spencer accidentally <u>*discovered*</u> microwave cooking.
- Passive Question:
- How <u>was</u> microwave cooking <u>discovered</u> (by Percy Spencer)?
- Passive Answer

Microwave cooking <u>was</u> accidentally <u>discovered</u> (by Percy Spencer).



When / Percy Spencer / discover / microwave cooking answer – in 1945 <u>simple past tense</u>

- Active Question:
- When <u>did</u> Percy Spencer <u>discover</u> microwave cooking?
- Active Answer:
- Percy Spencer <u>*discovered*</u> microwave cooking in 1945.
- Passive Question:
- When <u>was</u> microwave cooking <u>discovered</u> (by Percy Spencer)?
- Passive Answer

Microwave cooking <u>was discovered</u> (by Percy Spencer) in 1945.



• Active Question:

What *did* Thomas Edison *invent*?

Active Answer:



Thomas Edison *invented* the light bulb and phonograph.

• Passive Question:

What **was** *invented* by Thomas Edison?

Passive Answer

The light bulb and phonograph were invented by Thomas Edison.
