Task:

Choose a Master dissertation either in "Linguistics" or "Lit. & Civ. Read it, then:

A ccording to what you did study in the previous semester S 5 in this module, do the task:

- 1. How is the <u>title</u> built?
 - Does it reflect the study?
 - Is it coherent with it?
- 2. Is the <u>abstract</u> long or short?
 - Does it include pertinent information about the study such as: research problem, research method(s), findings .etc..?
 - How is it constructed?
 - How many keywords are there? Are they well selected?
- 3. Cite the components included in the introduction.

-What is the research problem of this study?

- How many research questions are there?
- -Are they effective for the study process?
- -To which extent are the hypotheses measurable if there are any?
- -What type(s) of research method(s) are used for conducting the research?
- -Are the tools and samples efficient and sufficient for this kind of research?

-When dealing with the literature review did the students analyse or just cite the works?

- How many <u>chapters</u> does the study consist of?
- 4. -What does the <u>conclusion</u> include?
 - -Give an example of the findings.
 - -Does it include any suggestions or recommendations?
 - Is it ended with any open question for further studies?
 - 5. -To which extent does the <u>bibliography</u> (and sitography) seem important for the study?

- 7. How was the analysis of the dissertation profitable to you?
